You will then apply your financial statement knowledge to the stock market, where you will discover how to analyze stocks and identify those that are profitable and worth your investment. Diving deeper, you will determine how to manage your investment portfolio by examining different asset classes, sectors, styles, and diversification options. To complete your certificate, you will delve into a more modern investment vehicle: cryptocurrency. You'll explore the function of blockchains by examining the design of a cryptocurrency and practice using a Bitcoin wallet to better understand how the blockchain can be used to transfer value from person to person. By the end of this program, you will have the knowledge and confidence to make investment decisions that will help you reach your financial goals, gaining applicable skills along the way.
