Program Description

The minor in feminist, gender and sexuality studies is an interdisciplinary program committed to feminist and queer scholarship.

This is a minor field. The initial application for admission is made only to major fields. After matriculation, a student may select FGSS as a minor concentration (<https://gradschool.cornell.edu/academic-progress/requirements/making-academic-progress/nominating-your-special-committee/>).

Graduate Minor Requirements

Students pursuing the minor in feminist, gender and sexuality studies are required to take FGSS 6880 Proseminar in Feminist, Gender, and Sexuality Studies.
